

Chinese Coins – with coins border

Quilt size is 57 x 74

Coins Strip width is 5 inches (5.5 inches with seam allowances)

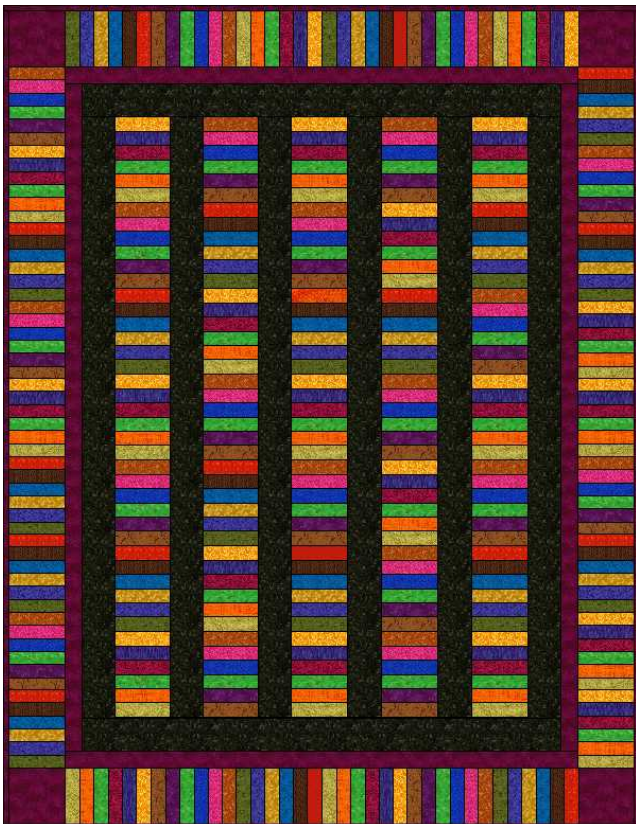
Length of vertical rows is approximately 54 inches (you can vary this to increase or decrease your quilt length)

Quilt Notes

- Although the diagram shows coins of equal width, I used coins of varying widths for my quilt.
- Ironing all seam allowances down makes sewing the sashing and borders much easier.
- Measure your quilt's length and width after adding purple border to determine the length needed for the final Coins borders. Cornerstones are added to the top and bottom Coins borders.

Cutting instructions

- Sashing and 1st black border are cut 3.5 inches wide
- 2nd purple border is cut 2 inches wide
- Cornerstones for Coins border are cut 5.5 inches square
- Final Coins border is 5.5 inches wide with seam allowances



Starting with a coins section, sew a sashing strip to the right side of 4 of the coins sections. The 5th section will not have a sashing strip sewn to it. Sew sections together using above picture as needed. I trim my top and bottom rows to even them up before putting my 1st black border on.
