


Blue/Green Stars

Quilt size is 51 x 65.5


Quilt is set 3 x 4 blocks

Block size is 12 inches (12.5 with seam allowance)



Cutting Instructions

You will need 12 blocks and each of the blocks are constructed from the following units.




(4) Double 4 patch blocks

(4) Hourglass blocks

(1) center block


You will need 4 of these units per block – these units should measure 4.5 inches with seam allowances.



Strips for the small 4 patches are cut 1.5 inches.


Larger squares are cut 2.5 inches.

You will need 4 hourglass units per block – these should measure 4.5 inches with seam allowances



Sew 4 hourglass blocks from squares that are cut 5.25 inches.

You will need 1 center unit per block – these should measure 4.5 inches with seam allowances



Center square is cut 2.5 inches

Corner squares are cut 1.5 inches

Background strip is cut 1.5 x 2.5 inches

You can strip piece these sections if you prefer.

Assembly

Assemble the above units into 12 blocks. Blocks will be set 3 x 4 rows. Refer to drawing on page 1.

- Sashing and cornerstones are cut 2 inches
- Inner green border is cut 2.5 inches
- Outer blue border is cut 4.5 inches
- Blue cornerstones are cut 6.5 inches.
- Inner and outer border will be sewn together as a unit and then sewn to the quilt. Sew the side borders on first and then sew cornerstones to the top and bottom borders and sew them to the quilt.
