

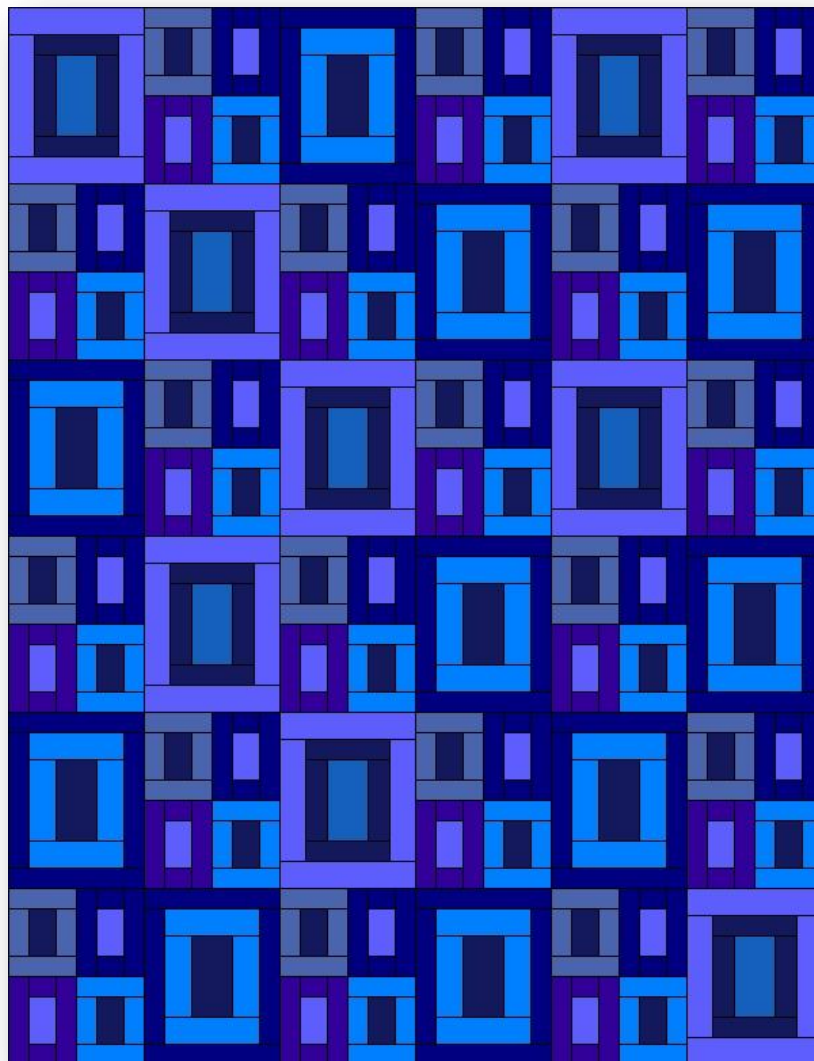
# Framed Rectangles

---

Quilt Size is 60 x 78

Block size is 10 x 13 inches (10.5 x 13.5 with seam allowances)

Setting is 6 x 6 blocks



## QUILT NOTES

- ✦ Cutting for this quilt is simple. The large rectangles are cut 3.5 x 6.5, and all the framing strips and the smaller rectangles are cut from 2 or 2.5 inch strips.

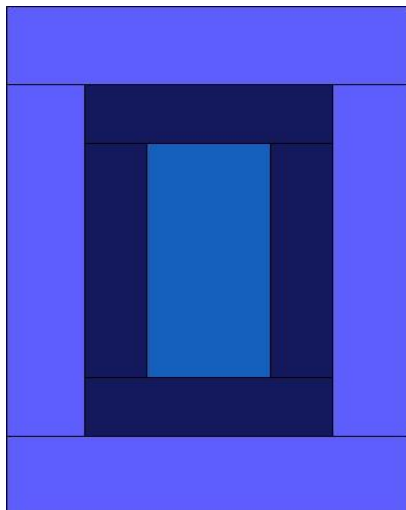
## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

### BLOCK A – MAKE 8

Inner rectangle is cut 3.5 x 6.5

Inner framing strips are cut 2 inches

Outer framing strips are cut 2.5 inches

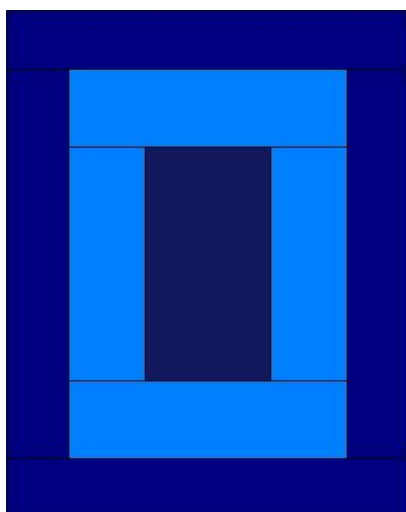


### BLOCK B – MAKE 10

Inner rectangle is cut 3.5 x 6.5

Inner framing strips are cut 2.5 inches

Outer framing strips are cut 2 inches

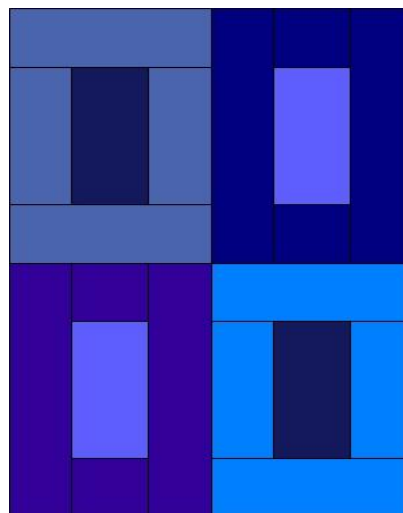


### BLOCK C - MAKE 18

Blocks are made up of 4 smaller rectangles; you will need 72 smaller rectangles to make these 18 blocks.

Cut center rectangles 2.5 x 4

Cut framing strips 2 inches



Note that the order the rectangles are framed is alternated in the above block so you don't have to match seams. Frame half of them starting on the side of the rectangle and frame half starting on the top and bottom.

### ASSEMBLY

The large rectangle blocks (A & B) will alternate with the small rectangle blocks (C). I scattered the A & B blocks through the quilt in a way that looked pleasing to me.

Lay blocks out 6 blocks across and 6 blocks down starting with a large rectangle block as show in the quilt on page one of these instructions.
